Clay County Board of Education will be participating in the Seamless Summer Option of National School Lunch Program and the School Breakfast Program. As part of this program, all Clay County Public Schools will offer healthy meals every school day at NO COST to all enrolled students. Clay County Elementary Schools will also offer meals to all children age 18 and younger (including children not enrolled) for school year 2021/2022. Students and all community children age 18 and younger will be able to participate in these meal programs without having to pay a fee or submit a household application.

Children 18 and younger not enrolled or not attending school in-person can pick meals up at any of the following locations when school is in session, Monday – Friday 10:15-10:30:

Big Creek Elementary, Burning Springs Elementary, Goose Rock Elementary, Hacker Elementary, Manchester Elementary, Oneida Elementary and Paces Creek Elementary
